The Pörtschacher Marble is one of the granular marbles of the old crystalline. Characteristic for him are his deposits of cloudy, light greenish and pinkish red, mostly very delicate coloring. Because of this extraordinary charm, it is often used in the design of art and everyday (light) objects.


Due to its excellent weather resistance, which can also be seen on countless buildings, memorials, grave monuments, walls and paving that go back to the Middle Ages, it has also proven to be versatile in the design of outdoor facilities.




The quarry
